**Thursday October 27th** Auction Committee Brunch & final committee meeting at Barb Hazelrigg's house at 10am.

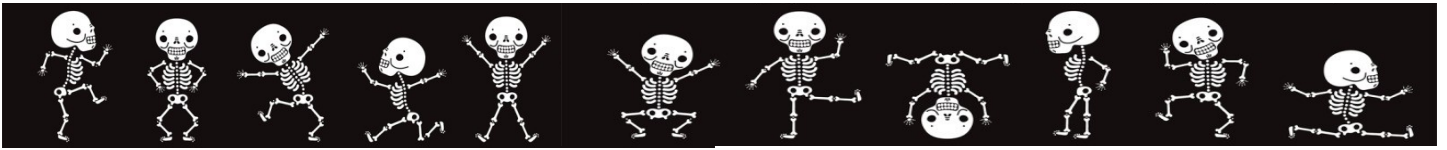
**Tuesday November 8th** last day to get business donations to Barb or Geo and this is the day the committee gets business donations organized at Jerri Cooper's house at 9am.
