Remember to wear your 60s outfit to the March 14th meeting. We are going to have a birthday party! You don't want to miss it.

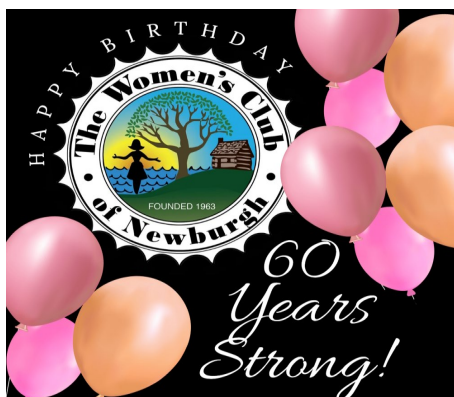
*Also, we will have presentation of proposals for grant recipients and the slate for 2023-2024 officers. It is a **Members Only** meeting, **No Guests**.*
